Good to Know Beer Definitions

AFTERTASTE

Residual flavor after swallowing. Called finish.

ALES

Characterized by fruity and floral aromas and flavors. All beer before recent history were ales.

AROMA

Eighty percent of perceived flavor comes from the olfactory senses.

BALANCE

The degree to which the primary characteristics of a beer work together. Typically used to describe the balance between malt (sweetness) and hops (bitterness).

BARLEY

The main ingredient in the majority of the world's beer, most suited to make bread. Contributes flavor, head, body and color.

BITTER

The terms, mild, ordinary bitter, special bitter, extra special bitter (ESB), pale ale and India pale ale (IPA), explain the degree to which hops are perceived.

BOCK

A lager traditionally brewed in winter. It is stronger in alcohol and may be a bit darker than regular strength lager.

BODY

The description of beer density. A thin watery beer is light in body. A mouth filling beer is said to be full bodied.

BROWN ALE

An ale brewed with the addition of some darker malt to yield a dark brown color. Flavor may include caramel, toffee and nuttiness.

COLOR

Malts are kilned or roasted at various temperatures for various lengths of time to yield malt to a range of colors, from pale straw to black.

DARK BEER

With the advent of the lighter colored lagers, the term is now used to describe any beer with color darker than typically found in common American beers.

DOPPLEBOCK

A lager brewed to higher alcohol strength than bock. Bock is typically 6.7% alcohol. Doppelbock is typically 7.8% alcohol.

HEFE

The German word for yeast. Indicating that a beer is unfiltered and typically cloudy in appearance.

HOPS

A tall growing vine, the female bud of which is used as a bittering and preserving agent in beer. Hops also impact aroma, flavor and adds to the aftertaste.

INDIAN PALE ALE

An ale brewed to higher alcohol and hopped more than usual to stand up to the three month voyage to India from England.

KRAUSEN

The German practice of adding young, still fermenting beer to mature beer in order to add carbonation.

LAGER

The German word that means "to store". In beer, it refers to the family of beers that are fermented at lower than room temperature and require more storage time to produce.

LIGHT BEER

The term "light" originally was used to distinguish lighter color beers from darker ones. However, in the United States, the term is synonymous with low calorie beer.

MALT

In beer, typically barley, but can be applied to any grain germinated to initiate the chemical reaction that will convert stored starches into the sugars needed by yeast to make alcohol.

PALE ALE

Usually amber or reddish in color. Pale ale was the term used in England to signify an extra special bitter (ESB) that has been bottled as opposed to served in a cask.

PILSNER

A style of lager that was Pilsner is a clear golden lager characterized by the firm hop flavor and aromas. American mass market beers are thinner examples of this style.

PORTER

Ale brewed with a firm addition of darker malts to produce a beer that is dark in color and characterized by notes of chocolate.

SCOTCH ALE

A popular ale in Scotland where barley is a major crop (used to make scotch whiskey) and hops are not. Characterized by a strong malt influence with minimal hop notes.

STOUT

An ale made with additions of dark roasted malted and unmalted barley to produce a black color that ranges from very dark to opaque.

WEISSE

German for "white beer," implying a pale colored brew made from wheat.

WHEAT

A common grain added to beer to promote head attention.

YEAST

Yeast is the organism that produces alcohol by ingesting sugar and creating alcohol and carbonation. Yeast also adds to a beer's flavor profile.
